



Wildlife for Everyone Foundation Scholarship Application

The Wildlife for Everyone Foundation (WFEF) invites undergraduate and graduate students who are aspiring conservationists, naturalists, biologists, ecologists and wildlife enthusiasts to apply for the 2022 WFEF scholarship.

Award – WFEF will award up to four (4)-\$750 scholarships that may be used to support expenses related to education or for participation in natural resource-related conferences, workshops, field experiences, books, etc. Award recipients also receive a one-year membership to the Wildlife for Everyone Foundation.

Requirements – Students enrolled in a Pennsylvania accredited college or university in a 2-year, 4-year or graduate program who actively participate in natural resource and conservation activities such as hunting, fishing, birding, habitat restoration, research and monitoring are eligible. Selection will be based on multiple factors including participation and outreach in natural resource-related activities, academic success, career goals and demonstration of leadership and communication skills. Previous scholarship recipients are ineligible. Awards will be presented at the 2022 WFEF Gala on Friday, April 8 in State College, PA. Winners will be encouraged to attend the event and will be provided with a complimentary ticket as well as overnight accommodations if needed.

- 2) School information – school, major, year
- 3) Membership in natural resource-related clubs and other organizations
- 4) Career goals
- 5) Participation in outdoor and wildlife-related activities and pursuits including research, monitoring, habitat management and outdoor recreation
- 6) Outreach activities and mentoring related to increasing access to and /or participation in wildlife-related outdoor pursuits
